



Green patrol

A century-old colonial building that was home to the first police headquarters in the New Territories has been turned into a green oasis to promote sustainable living. Green Hub, run by the Kadoorie Farm and Botanic Garden, was selected by the Development Bureau to transform Old Tai Po Police Station, which had been disused since 1987. It will offer guided tours, cookery and conservation courses, accommodation in residential quarters for educational retreats, and a vegetarian canteen. At yesterday's opening, Chief Executive Leung Chun-ying said: "[These sites] can truly serve the community again, while preserving their original flair."
